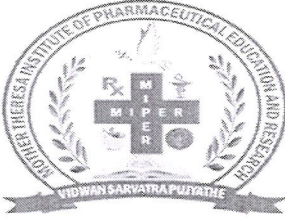

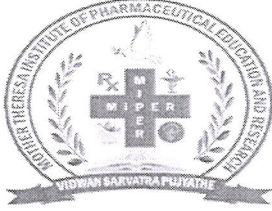

Volunteer Participation: The program witnessed enthusiastic participation from our college students who volunteered their time and efforts to make the event a success.

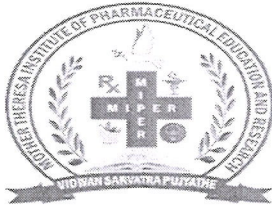
Conclusion:

Highlights:

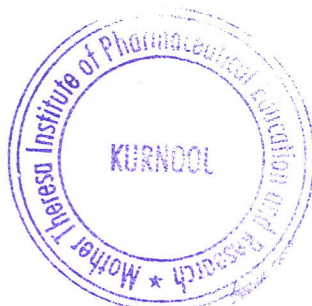
Clean-Up Drive: In an effort to reduce mosquito breeding sites, volunteers organized a clean-up drive in and around the village.

Community Awareness Rally:

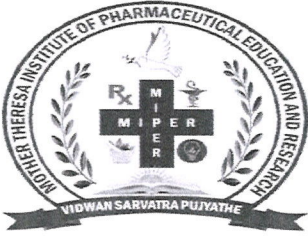
