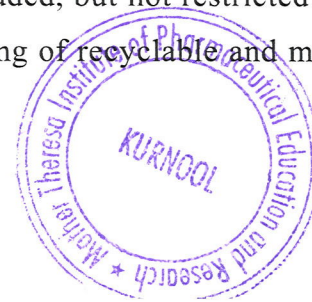
NOW Therefore, in consideration of the a foresaid and the mutual promises between the parties under this Agreement, the parties here to agree as follows:

1. Now This MOU Witnessed as Under:

This is an agreement for a synergic alliance between "**Mother Theresa Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research, Kurnool**" and **Kurnool Municipal corporation** for the cause of recycling of Solid waste and to protect environment, conserve natural resources, inculcate the habit of source segregation among the citizens, recover and recycle the solid recyclables which is going to landfill and create a sustainable livelihood to the informal sectors

2. Scope:

- While this agreement is in force, **Mother Theresa Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research, Kurnool** shall ensure that all the solid recyclables will be disposed only through its associated partner
- Rates for recyclables will be displayed time to time on recycle.
- **Mother Theresa Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research, Kurnool** will rise involves of the value to be received against the disposal of recyclable.
- The sustainability certificate for responsible disposal through the municipal corporation will be provided and the same can be accessed.
- **Mother Theresa Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research, Kurnool** is required to provide necessary entry and exit permissions included, but not restricted to gate-pass, other access formalities to use its space for loading of recyclable and man power movement during the time of pickup.



The project shall be valid and can be renewed for additional periods and quantities as per mutual agreement of Mother Theresa Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research, Kurnool and Municipal Corporation of Kurnool.

3. Indemnity:

Mother Theresa Institute of Pharmaceutical Education and Research, Kurnool, shall be solely responsible for collection and storage of category wise recyclables in their premises.

Term:

This agreement shall come into force from the date of signing and remain valid for a period of 36 months, including final payment and documentation whichever is earlier unless terminated earlier by the parties. The Agreement may be extended for such further periods and quantities as may be agreed to by the parties

Amendment: Any Amendment to this agreement shall be valid and binding on the parties only if it is made in writing and signed by duly authorized representatives of each party


